Eucharistic Congress

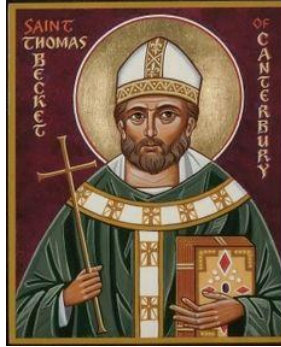
