Tideway Tunnel

The Tideway Tunnel is in the process of being dug from Acton in the west to Abbey Mills in the east with various feeder tunnels, a combined route of 25km. It will carry sewage in order to avoid it being discharged into the River Thames. This will be of major environmental benefit to the river and the city but comes at a cost of £4.2 billion. One of the tributary tunnels is being dug from Dormay Street on the river to King George's Park. On Tuesday 4th December Father Alex blessed a statue of St Barbara, the patron saint of tunnelers, and presided over a short ceremony during which her statue was placed in a small shrine at the entrance to the tunnel.
