Receiving Holy Communion Properly

Who can receive?

 All members of the Catholic Church not conscious of serious sin and in good standing who have fasted for one hour are welcome to receive Holy Communion. If you are aware of serious sin you must go to confession beforehand. Holy Communion is not available to members of non-Catholic Churches.

Asking for a Blessing

 Those who are non-Catholic or cannot receive Holy Communion may come up with their arms crossed on their chest to receive a blessing.

Reverence

 Make a reverential bow as you step up to receive both the Body and Blood of Christ.

Communion on the Hand

- Hold your clean hands chest-high and outstretched to receive the Eucharist with your right hand supporting the left one.
- Consume the host <u>immediately</u>. If you walk away with the host in your hand, the priest or extraordinary minister may come to make sure you consume the host.
- Receive Communion reverently with an out-stretched hand. Do not "take" or "grab" the host from the minister.

Communion on the Tongue

 If receiving on the tongue, join your hands and reverently put out your tongue.

Communion from the Chalice

- If receiving from the chalice, make sure you have a firm grip on the chalice and the minister has firmly re-grasped it after you have taken a small sip of the Precious Blood.
- If you are ill, please do not receive from the chalice.
- Do not dip the host into the chalice.

Response

 When the minister says, "Body of Christ" or "Blood of Christ", the response is a clear "Amen!"

It is important to receive Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament in a reverent manner and following these guidelines will help you to do so.

Altar Servers

If any of the children who have just made their First Communion this year wishes to become an Altar Server they should come along to the Sacristy about ten minutes before mass so we can get them ready. We can then induct them into the mysteries of Altar Serving gradually over a period of time. We value their contribution.
